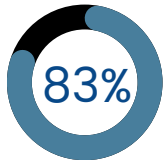

RWD has hired 50 total interns since the inception of the program in 2016



82% of interns hired completed the program



83% have found full time employment in the water utility sector



EXAMPLE OF DUTIES

- Assist with general maintenance and repair of potable and recycled water transmission and distribution systems.
- Perform related water system facilities maintenance and repair work as assigned.
- Install new water meters and meter boxes.
- Assist in collecting and recording water supply and water quality data for mandatory compliance and reporting purposes.
- Operate various types of construction equipment including pneumatic jackhammers or similar equipment to remove dirt, concrete or asphalt.
- Repair/replace leaking angle stop valves.
- Check operation and repair or replace faulty water meters or meter boxes.
